This annual report is more than a financial statement; it is a chronicle of survival, dignity, and the relentless pursuit of a hunger-free Uttarakhand. Since our inception in 2020, Dev Bhoomi Samiti has stood as a shield for those whom society has chosen to forget. In the foothills of the Himalayas, amidst the beauty of Dehradun, there exists a hidden world of immense suffering—leprosy colonies where the residents battle not just a debilitating disease, but the crushing weight of social exile. In the 2024–25 financial year, our mission reached its most critical stage. With an audited income of over ₹43.36 Lakh, we transformed donor contributions into a lifeline for 84 leprosy patients residing in KKM Colony Nalapani, Shanti Kust Aashram, and Rotary Kust Aashram. This report details how we utilize these resources to provide monthly nutritional security, specialized medical aid for decaying limbs, and basic human dignity to those who can no longer even cook a meal for themselves due to physical deformity.

GENESIS – A PROMISE MADE IN THE SHADOWS

The foundation of Dev Bhoomi Samiti is rooted in a single, heart-wrenching moment that occurred in 2020. Our founders, then merely school students, witnessed a sight that stripped away their innocence: a man so ravaged by hunger that he was desperately scavenging for scraps of food from a garbage heap. This visual of extreme human degradation in the heart of Dehradun became the catalyst for a lifelong movement.

That day, a promise was made—a promise that no soul in their community would ever have to suffer such a fate again. With no institutional backing, no funds, and only a shared fire in their hearts, these students went from shop to shop, begging for small donations of ration or coins to feed the starving. They faced rejection and coldness from many, but the few who opened their hearts provided enough to serve the first of thousands of meals.

Dev Bhoomi Samiti officially registered on September 26, 2020, evolving from a student-led initiative into a professional NGO. Today, we have completed over nine years of service, providing education, healthcare, and livelihood support across Uttarakhand, but our heart remains with the "invisible poor"—the leprosy patients who live in the shadows of our city.



VISION, MISSION, AND THE MORAL OBLIGATION

Our vision is a society where physical deformity is not a death sentence for social dignity. We strive for a Uttarakhand where the residents of leprosy ashrams are seen as human beings entitled to care, not as outcasts to be feared.

Our Core Mission Pillars:

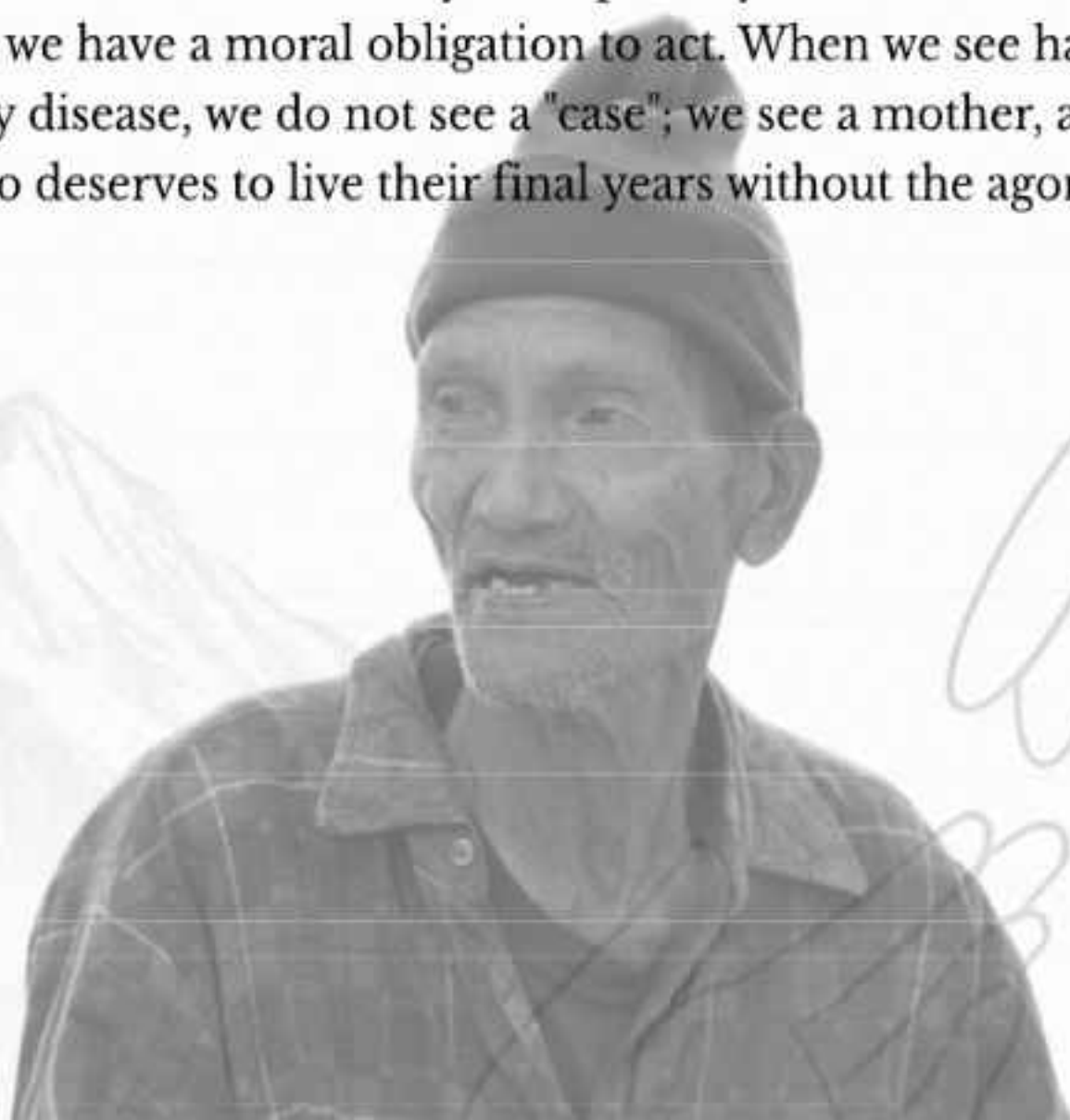
Nutritional Security: To ensure that the 84 leprosy patients in our care receive a consistent, high-quality monthly ration kit, acknowledging that many have lost the fingers and strength required to even cook their own food.

Medical Intervention: To provide specialized medical care for decaying limbs, preventing the spread of infection through daily dressing supplies and MCR footwear.

Social Restoration: To fight the debilitating stigma that leads to the ostracization of patients, offering them a sense of belonging and community.

Holistic Development: Beyond leprosy, we are committed to empowering women through SHGs and educating underprivileged children to break the cycle of poverty.

We believe we have a moral obligation to act. When we see hands and feet ravaged by disease, we do not see a "case"; we see a mother, a father, or a brother who deserves to live their final years without the agony of hunger.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE – PRAVESH UNIYAL

"I write this message with a heavy heart but a resolute spirit. In our visits to KKM Colony Nalapani, Shanti Kust Aashram, and Rotary Kust Aashram, we witness the true face of human suffering. I have seen men and women whose limbs have slowly decayed, leaving them incapable of performing the simplest tasks of daily life. It is a devastating reality that in 2026, people are still living in such dire conditions within our city. In the financial year 2024–25, we managed a total income of ₹43,36,298, and I want every donor to know that this money was used as a shield against this misery. We spent ₹30.43 Lakh on food distribution and ₹7 Lakh on medical aid. This is not just 'charity'; it is the fulfillment of a debt we owe to humanity. My focus remains on the 84 patients who depend on us every single month for their survival. We will not stop until every resident in these ashrams can live with the respect they deserve."

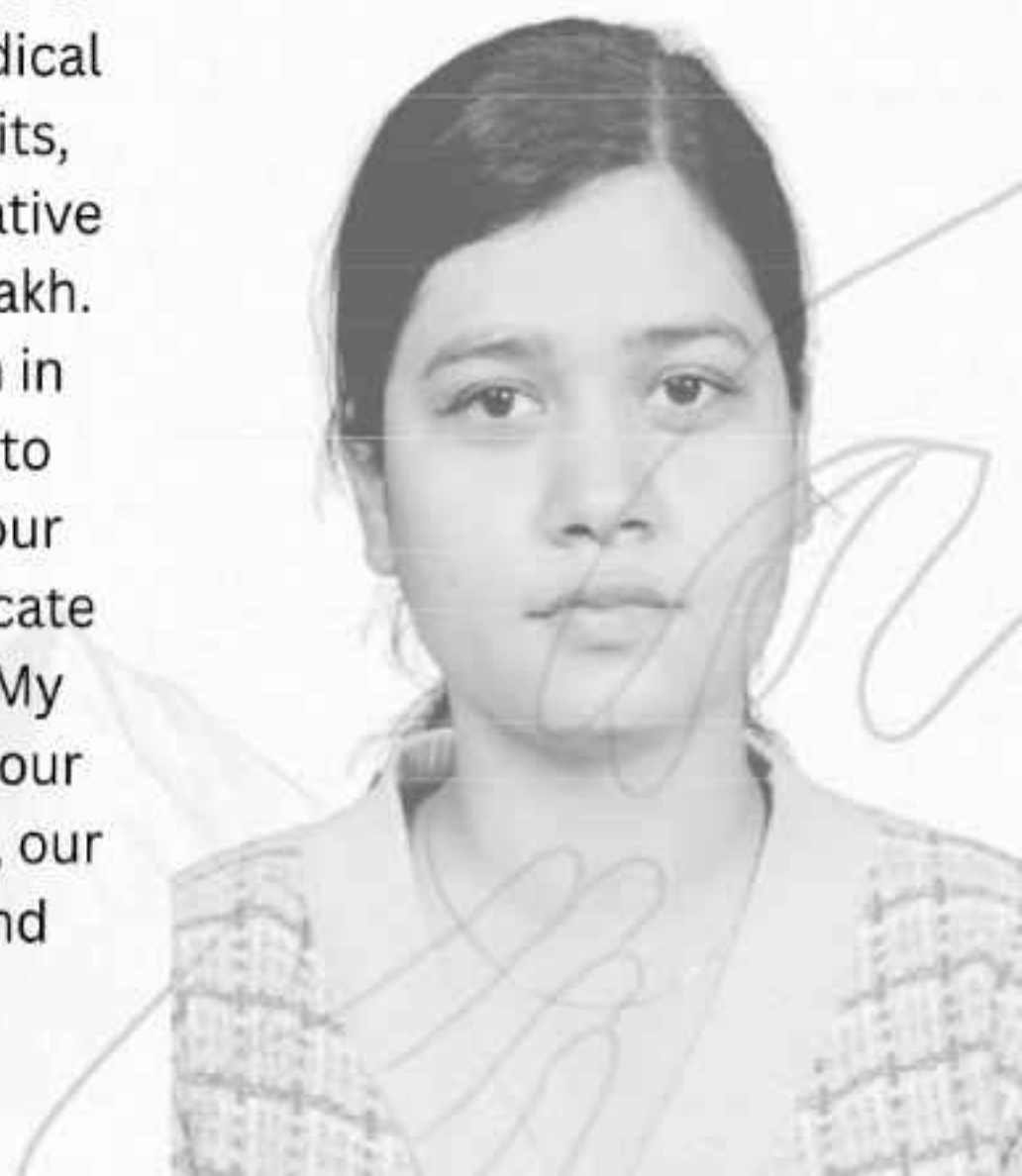


SECRETARY'S MESSAGE – SWATI

"Administrative excellence and legal transparency are the foundations upon which we build our service. This year, Dev Bhoomi Samiti reached a significant milestone by receiving provisional registrations under Section 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act. These are not just certificates; they are a guarantee to our donors that our operations in Dehradun are conducted with the highest integrity.

We are acutely aware of the desperate state of the leprosy colonies. To ensure that 90% of our funds go directly to medical dressings and nutritional kits, we have kept our administrative expenses strictly at ₹4.34 Lakh. We also invested ₹1.5 Lakh in new digital infrastructure to better track the needs of our beneficiaries and communicate their stories to the world. My role is to ensure that while our hearts are with the patients, our books are open and beyond reproach."

THE FORGOTTEN COLONIES – KKM NALAPANI & SHANTI KUST AASHRAM

The core of Dev Bhoomi Samiti's operations is centered in three specific locations that most of society has turned its back on: KKM Colony Nalapani, Shanti Kust Aashram, and Rotary Kust Aashram. These settlements, nestled in the outskirts of Dehradun, house a community of 84 leprosy patients who live in a state of dual trauma—physical decay and social isolation.

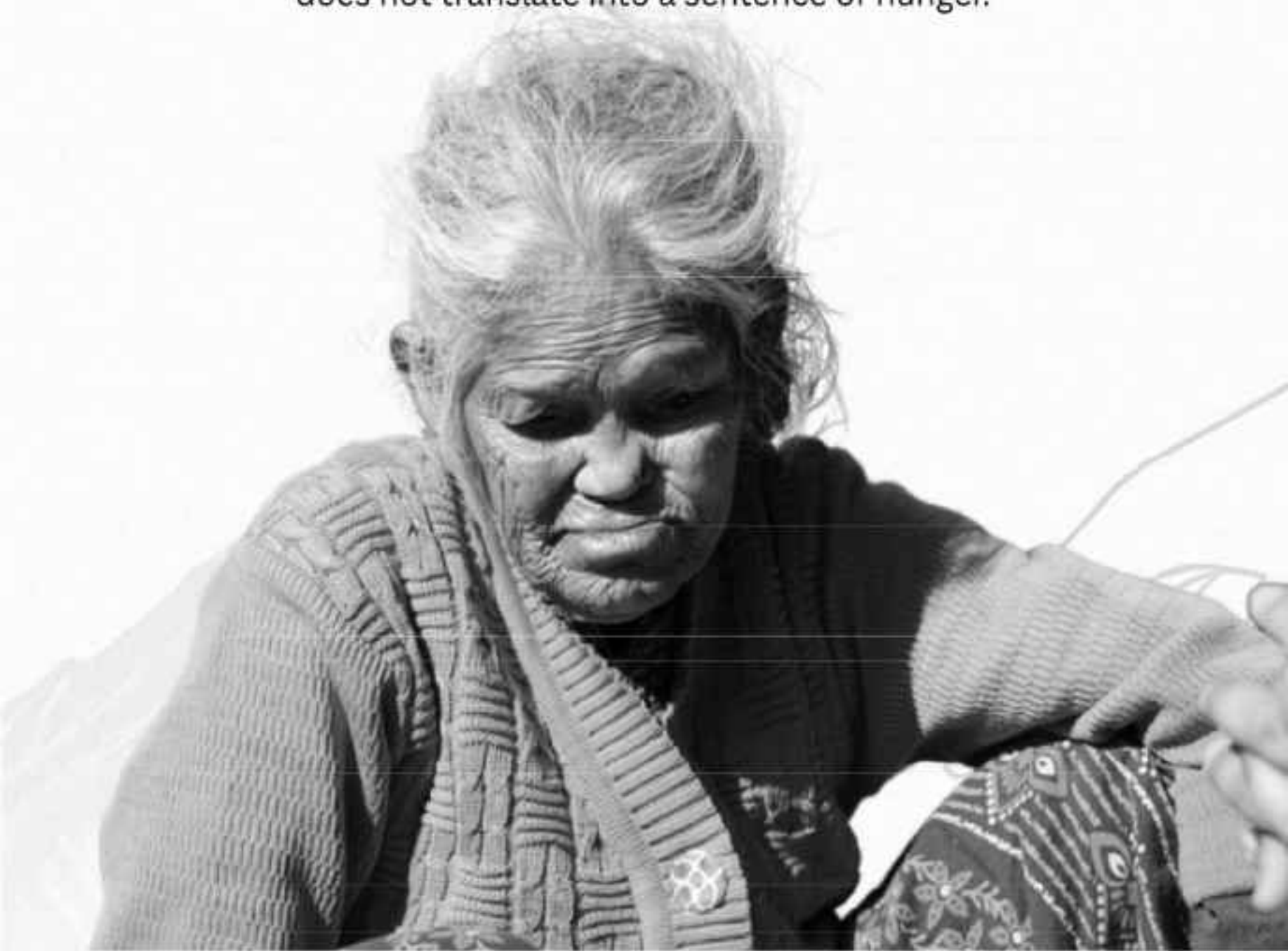
Leprosy is a chronic infectious disease that, if left untreated or poorly managed, causes severe nerve damage and visible disfigurement. At these colonies, the reality is stark. We encounter residents whose hands and feet have reached a state of advanced decay. Many have lost fingers and toes, leaving them with "stumps" that make the most basic human movements a struggle. The environment in these ashrams is one of "Resilient Suffering," where the residents battle daily to maintain their humanity while their bodies fail them. Dev Bhoomi Samiti has pledged to be their permanent guardian, ensuring that while they may be isolated from the city, they are never isolated from care.



BEYOND DISABILITY – THE CHALLENGE OF SURVIVAL

In KKM Colony Nalapani and Shanti Kust Aashram, the level of disability is so profound that it transcends the need for simple "aid". Many of our 84 beneficiaries have reached a stage where they cannot perform the fundamental tasks required for survival. Because leprosy attacks the nerves, the loss of sensation leads to repeated injuries, which eventually result in the "rotting" or shortening of limbs.

A significant number of these individuals can no longer grip a spoon to eat or light a match to cook a meal. Their hands are no longer functional tools, but symbols of their struggle. This creates a dependency that is absolute. Without our monthly intervention, these residents would be unable to secure or prepare food, leading to a slow and painful decline. We recognize that for someone whose hands are ravaged by disease, a bag of raw rice is not enough; they need a system of support that understands their physical limitations. Our mission is to bridge this gap, ensuring that their physical inability to cook does not translate into a sentence of hunger.



NUTRITIONAL SECURITY – FEEDING THE 84

Nutrition is the first line of defense against the progression of leprosy. In the financial year 2024–25, Dev Bhoomi Samiti invested ₹30,43,250 into food distribution. A major portion of this budget was dedicated to the monthly ration kits for the 84 residents of the leprosy ashrams.

The Nutritional Kit Program:

Monthly Delivery: We ensure that on a fixed date every month, every patient at KKM Nalapani and the other ashrams receives a comprehensive ration kit.

Balanced Diet: Each kit is packed with 10kg Rice, 5kg Wheat Flour, 2kg Pulses, 1 Litre of Cooking Oil, and essential spices. This ensures they have the carbohydrates and proteins necessary for their bodies to maintain some level of immunity.

Consistency: For a patient in Shanti Kust Aashram, this kit represents the difference between life and death. By providing a full month's supply, we remove the daily anxiety of "where will my next meal come from?".



MEDICAL INTERVENTION FOR DECAYING LIMBS

The most harrowing aspect of our work is the medical care required for advanced leprosy. We allocated ₹7,00,000 this year specifically for Medical Aid to the Poor. In the leprosy colonies, wounds do not heal easily. Because patients lack sensation, they often do not feel injuries, leading to deep ulcers and infections that cause the "rotting" sensation often described.

Our Medical Support Includes:

Daily Dressing Supplies: We provide high volumes of antiseptic liquids, sterile bandages, and ointments. Many patients require daily cleaning of their wounds to prevent gangrene.

MCR Footwear: We facilitate the distribution of specialized Micro-Cellular Rubber (MCR) shoes. These are vital for patients at Rotary Kust Aashram, as they protect insensitive feet from the friction and injuries that lead to permanent disfigurement.

Medication Facilitation: While the government provides basic MDT (Multi-Drug Therapy), we provide the supportive medicines and vitamins needed to manage the severe side effects and pain associated with leprosy reactions.



HYGIENE, WATER, AND HUMAN DIGNITY

Living with leprosy requires a high standard of hygiene to prevent secondary infections, yet the residents of KKM Colony often lack the resources for basic cleanliness. Dev Bhoomi Samiti addresses this through a holistic "Dignity Kit" provided alongside rations.

Water Security: We are actively involved in ensuring that the colonies have access to clean water for bathing and cleaning wounds, which is a fundamental requirement for health.

Personal Care Items: Monthly supplies include antiseptic soaps, detergents for washing clothes, oils, and dental hygiene products.

Living Conditions: We provide bedding and warm clothes to ensure that their living environment is as clean and comfortable as possible.

By providing these items, we aren't just giving "supplies"; we are restoring the self-respect of individuals who have been told by the world that they are "unclean". We stand with them as their family, proving that every human being deserves a life of dignity, regardless of their physical condition.

BEYOND THE ASHRAMS – FEEDING DEHRADUN'S POOR

While our heart and soul are dedicated to the 84 residents of the leprosy colonies, Dev Bhoomi Samiti's mission to eradicate hunger extends across the city of Dehradun. We recognize that poverty is not confined to colony walls; it exists under flyovers, outside railway stations, and at the gates of government hospitals. In the financial year 2024-25, we utilized our massive food budget of ₹30,43,250 to provide nutritional security to the "invisible poor".

Our volunteers identify areas of extreme need—such as Sahastradhara Road and Nalapani Chowk—where homeless families and daily wage laborers struggle to find a single meal. By providing dry ration kits and cooked meals to these populations, we ensure that the Samiti's impact is felt throughout the urban landscape of Uttarakhand. We believe that providing a meal is the first step toward restoring a person's hope and physical strength to fight for a better future.



EMERGENCY RELIEF – WINTER & DISASTER SUPPORT

Uttarakhand's geography makes its people vulnerable to both harsh Himalayan winters and sudden natural disasters. Dev Bhoomi Samiti remains prepared to act as a first responder during these crises. During the peak winter months of 2024-25, we launched a city-wide "Winter Relief" drive to protect those sleeping in the open.

Blanket Distribution: We distributed high-quality blankets to the homeless near the Dehradun Railway Station and ISBT.

Warm Clothing: Essential winter wear, including sweaters and caps, was provided to children in slum areas to prevent cold-related illnesses.

Disaster Readiness: Our team maintains a reserve of dry rations to deploy immediately in the event of landslides or floods in the surrounding hilly regions.

Medical Kits: Winter-specific medicines and skin care ointments were added to our distribution for leprosy patients to manage cracked skin and infections during the cold.

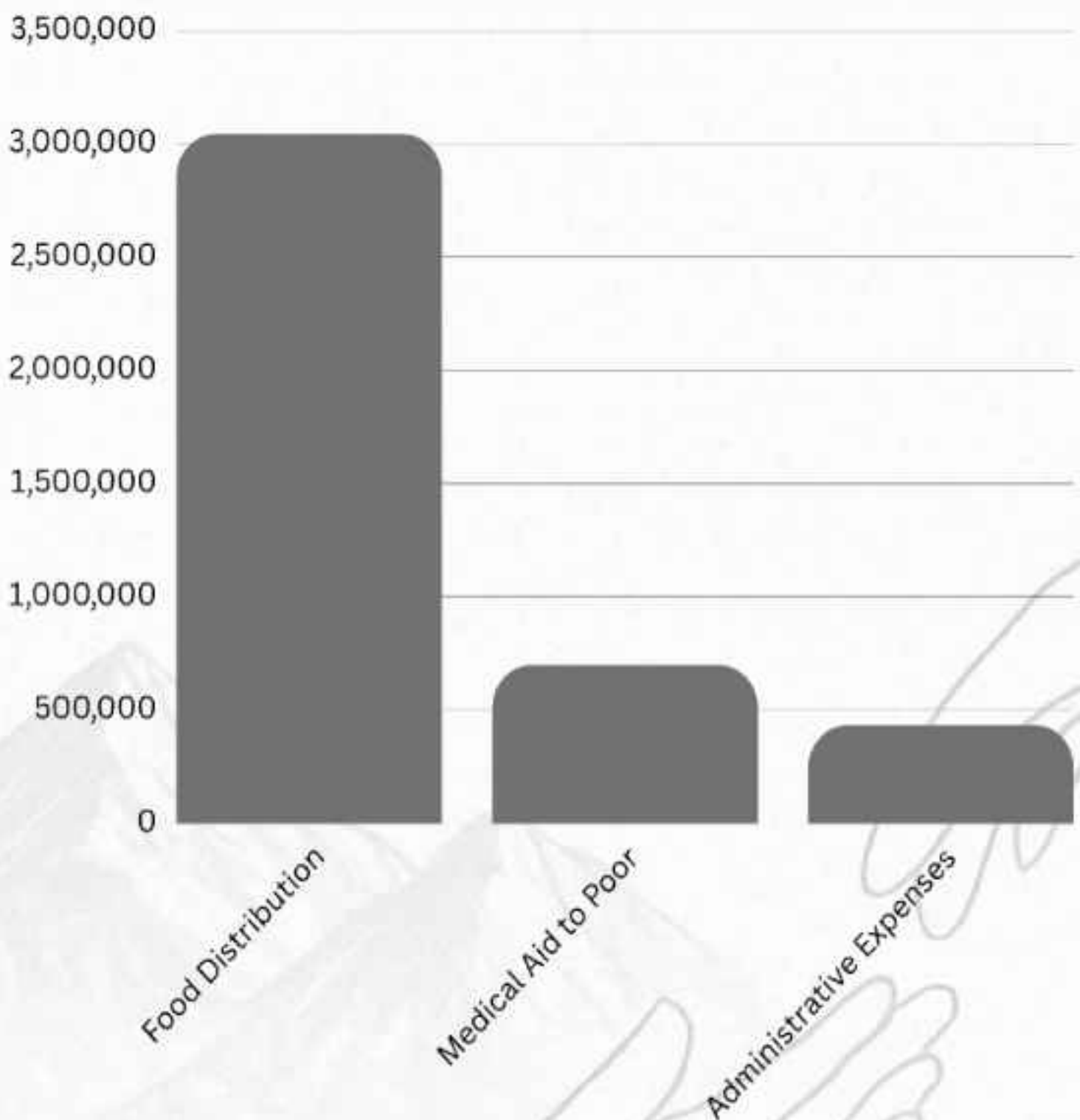

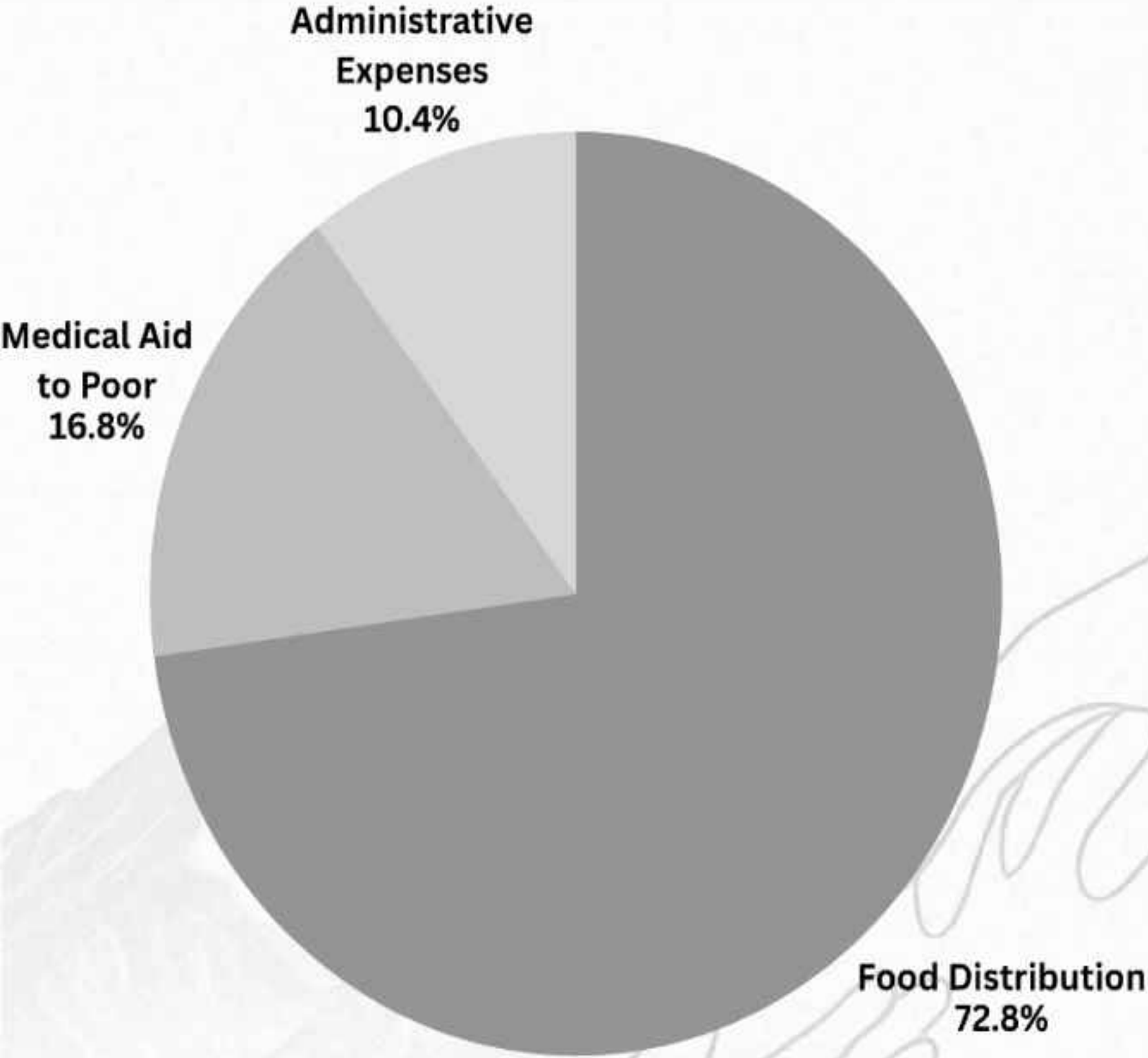
Charitable Activity Expenses: ₹3,743,250.00 (89.6% of total spend).

To operate at this scale, Dev Bhoomi Samiti maintains rigorous administrative and legal standards. We believe that professional management is key to long-term sustainability.

12A & 80G Certification: We received provisional registration under Section 12A and 80G in early 2025, allowing for tax exemptions and encouraging higher donor engagement.

NGO Darpan: Our Unique ID UA/2020/0268127 ensures we are recognized by the NITI Aayog for government collaborations.

Office Infrastructure: We invested ₹150,000.00 in new digital assets (Computers/Laptops) this year to improve our reporting and beneficiary tracking.

Audit Fees: A professional fee of ₹18,800.00 was paid to ensure our accounts meet statutory standards.

Operational Base: Our headquarters on Sahastradhara Road serves as the nerve center for all Dehradun operations.

Field Force: Our team is comprised of 50 male and 35 female volunteers, totaling 85 dedicated souls who manage the distribution of monthly rations and medical supplies.

Compassionate Service: Our volunteers go beyond material aid; they provide the emotional support and social integration that leprosy patients so desperately need.

Breaking Myths: By interacting directly with the residents of KKM Colony Nalapani and Shanti Kust Aashram, our volunteers act as ambassadors of change, proving that leprosy is treatable and that patients deserve love, not fear.



FUTURE ROADMAP – THE VISION FOR 2025–26

While we are proud of our achievements this year, the road ahead remains challenging. Leprosy continues to be a social and medical hurdle in Uttarakhand.

Scaling Impact: Our goal is to increase our monthly support from 84 to 150 leprosy-affected individuals across Dehradun and surrounding districts.

Project Ashray: We are planning the construction of a dedicated shelter home for abandoned elderly citizens who have no family to care for them.

Mobile Medical Unit: To better serve patients with decaying limbs who cannot travel, we aim to launch a mobile unit for doorstep wound dressing and medical check-ups.

Digital Empowerment: Building on our investment in technology, we will launch a digital tracking system to monitor the long-term health recovery of our core beneficiaries.
